<i>NON-LIVE ENTERTAINMENT</i>	<i>Description</i>	<i>Fee Range</i>
Non-Live I	Radio, Portable audio device, piped in music, music by electrical or mechanical means, background music, and CD player	\$50
Non-Live II	Non-Live I, jukebox and/or no more than 5 TV's	\$50
Non-Live III	Non-Live I, jukebox and more than 5 TV's	\$100
<i>LIVE ENTERTAINMENT</i>	<i>Description</i>	<i>Fee</i>
Live I	Instrumental/Vocal music not to exceed a total of 3 performers (if adding DJ, dancing by patrons or karaoke, see Live II)	\$100
Live II	Instrumental/Vocal music exceeding 3 performers and/or DJ and/or dancing by patrons and/or karaoke (regardless of the number of performers)	\$200
