**New Business** 

- 1. Kelly reviewed how she is in the process for FY 2024 new growth. She has been collecting data from building permits and other means. Kelly stated that the \$250,000 goal for new growth will be met with no issues.
- 2. Kelly discussed that there were 6 new Betterment Privilege fee assessments that were mailed out on August 14<sup>th</sup>, 2023. The taxpayers received a letter with a choice for how many years they would like for the Betterment, between five years, ten years, fifteen years or twenty years. The taxpayers have to make a decision by September 14<sup>th</sup>, 2023 otherwise it is up to the Board of Assessors to decide for them.

- 3. Kelly informed The Board that there will be a Fall Town Meeting on Monday, November 6<sup>th</sup>, 2023. The Board of Selectmen are looking to close the warrant by mid-September. Currently, the Assessors do not have anything to present at this meeting.
- 4. The next Board of Assessors meeting will be Wednesday, October 4<sup>th</sup>, 2023 at 4:00 p.m.
