19 Darling Street – Title V & Sanitary Code Violations: Agent Correia updated the board that the Engineer and the homeowner are having a meeting with Dan Menard, Department of Public Works to make sure everything is in order. Mr. Davignon make a motion to keep on agenda to see plans drawn in the near future – Mr. Fortin seconded the motion - all were in favor motion carries.

Sewer Summit: Agent Correia updated that they intend on doing this in October, Woodard & Curran is going to present to all the board(s) a plan of need areas, cost, ect... And once the first meeting happens, all future meetings with this summit we be more detailed in moving forward on project areas. 
