Reorganize

Thomas Fortin from Chairman to Inspector, Robert Medeiros from Clerk to Chairman, David Davignon from Inspector to Clerk. Per the suggestion of Chairman Fortin, D. Davignon made a motion to table the reorganization, R. Medeiros seconded the motion, all were in favor. So voted.

Appointment

James Souza, 183 Mattapoisett Road, noise complaints. Chairman Fortin moved the floor over to Health Agent Correia so he could update the board on what activity has been going on at 181 Mattapoisett Road where there is a noise issue. Mr. Souza claims the neighbor is running a cord wood business. All testimony from the neighbor, Harold Perry at 181 Mattapoisett Road, by phone or to the building department has claimed that he and his neighbors share the wood and that Mr. Perry and his neighbors do all the cutting and splitting on Mr. Perry's property. Evidence from Mr. Souza shows excessive noise from such activities he can't enjoy any peace and quiet on his property for approximately 5 years now. Mr. Souza would like this to not continue into the next year. More discussion ensued about times, dates and pictures showing evidence showing that this looks like a running business and should not be allowed in a residential neighborhood. Chairman Fortin would like to start with letters to the Selectman's office to determine if this is a business and go from there. D. Davignon is in favor and agrees that this activity is a nuisance. D. Davignon made a motion to send a letter to the Selectman's office for their determination if this is in fact a wood cutting business, R. Medeiros second the motion, all were in favor. So voted.

D. Davignon would like to keep this discussion on the next agenda.

August 23, 2022 (R.M. absent). D. Davignon made a motion to approve these minutes, Chairman Fortin seconded the motion, both were in favor. So voted.






