

## EXECUTIVE SESSION – NOVEMBER 16, 2020

Chairman Gaspar motioned to go into Executive Session – roll call vote, Selectman Desroches yes, Selectman Wojnar yes, -all in favor.

### Discussion Ensued:

After review of plans on 11/5 in the agreement Keating haven't provided what they promised. Open meeting with P.J. Keating since we decided to go forward. PJ Keating filed an appeal with preliminary injunction. KP Law, Jeff Blake to bring back to both courts never hurts to bring back to both sides and hear what they have to say. Drafted request opposition to the Town request. Jeff Blake draft letter to the Attorney General and move forward. Some violations they are working around have been filed and additional violations may come. The Board of Selectmen last charge told Blake to go full steam ahead.

Selectman Gaspar spoke of time lines that they have done a lot more since the 5<sup>th</sup> of November.

Pat Hannon – Wetlands delineations plan not completed due to surveyor having Covid. The last one was in 2010 existing plan. They did supply us with an existing survey plan. Pat's plan is estimated because they could not confirm since they had a Covid outbreak.

Selectman Wojnar not interested in meeting with P.J. Keating and let Board of Health handle it.

Selectman Gaspar reviewed plans, continued working unanimously with other peoples' views. Selectman Gaspar wants, Jeff Blake, to know that the vote should be continued to work forward with P.J. Keating.

David Desroches is very dissatisfied with all plans the vote is not going to change in air quality and three (3) years of listening to illegally discharging in the Acushnet River. Jeff Blake/KP Law has marching orders – 9<sup>th</sup> Zoom meeting – Merilee and Fire Chief.

Attorney General letter precluded from bringing into open session.

Attorney General will be an open letter through Department of Environmental Protection, not enforcing and need our help. Going forward Hannon had Selectman Gaspar watch water testing with Hannon and saw the testing was improperly done.


November 5<sup>th</sup> vote feels different than what was voted previously, Kevin wants to be on record he does not agree.


