OLD BUSINESS:

- 1. The 2018 "Car Show" will be held on the "Friends Meetinghouse" grounds August 12, 2018. Members from the Acushnet Agriculture Commission stated that some old tractors, horses, goats, ponies and a petting zoo to be available for youngsters attending this event.
- 2. This Car Show will have the "Downshifters Car Club" on site and will be held from 10:00 am to 4:00 pm. DJ "Johnny Angel" will be playing music as well as food being available on site. A section of the grounds will be available for an car parts Swap Meet. A "Gift to Give" trailer will also be on site to accept any donations of clothing. A 50/50 Raffle will also be held with monies to be used for Town historical properties.
- Scott did state that some Saturday Farmers Market vendors are to be available to display their wares.
- 4. The new 24-volt alarm system has been installed at the Museum, replacing the old 12-volt system that is out dated.

- 2. Linda Guilbeault gave a talk on creating a "Raffle Calendar" to be sold starting in November of 2018, for 2019. This calendar would be in color and any monies collected would be used for repairs to the "Perry Hill Church."
- 3. Linda also talked about possibly having a catered meal to be put on by "Mac's Soda Bar Fairhaven" and being held at the Senior Center, with raffle tickets being sold for a very reasonably priced meal. Again, with funds raised to benefit repairing the "Perry Hill Church." A date was established to have this affair on either October 6 or 13, 2018 (6:00 pm to 8:00 pm) with the raffle drawing at the end.

ANY OTHER BUSINESS:

- 1. As of yet, there is no information as to a replacement for retired member Joyce Reynolds?
- 2. Town personnel will again be used to clean up the Museum as they have in the past.
- 3. Problems with the wooden exterior surface rotting at the Museum west wall have been discovered. Painting will also be taking place here in either late August or early September 2018. Two (2) powered lift machines will have to be ordered for use by the Sheriffs Department personal in advance of when work will begin.
