III. Approve Septic Design Plans/Subdivision Plan Review

1. 336 Mendall Road – Melvin West – Collins Civil Eng. Group

Septic repair plan. 2 variances requested. 1. Groundwater reduction from 4 feet to 3 feet. 2. Sieve analysis in lieu of a percolation test. 3. BWV setback to be 50 feet rather than 75 feet as required by Acushnet BOH policy.

2. 78 Peckham Road – Richard Koestner – Foresight Engineering

Septic repair plan. 5 variances requested. 1. A reduction of the setback of the proposed leach field from the existing wetlands for 50' to a minimum of 15'. A liner is to be installed around the entire perimeter of the system. 2. A reduction of the proposed septic tank from the existing wetlands from 25' to a minimum of 15'. 3. A reduction of the setback of the proposed leach field from the existing water line from 10' to a minimum of 5'. A liner is to be installed around the entire perimeter of the system at a depth greater than the waterline. 4. Sieve analysis in lieu of a percolation test. 5. A reduction of the setback of the proposed leach filed from the existing wetlands from 75' to a minimum of 19' as shown on plan. Due to existing waterline and gas utilities area is limited on site for the leaching system.
