- 2. The 41A income increase to \$55,000 annually passed at Town Meeting on 5.14.2018. The change to this clause also effects MGL Chapter 80 Section 13B for those 65 and older who may apply for deferral of special assessments...
- Phase III Sewer Betterments committed and bills mailed 4.18.2018. The net 30-day interest free time expired 5.18.2018. The Board of Assessors needs to vote on the timeframe of payment for those still unpaid.
