Old Business:

NOI – Town of Acushnet DPW SE 001-0541 A Notice of Intent was filed by the Town of Acushnet DPW for property located on Hamlin Street, Map 23 & 24, lots 22, 26, 26A and 18-26, 23A, 23C, 23D, 25 A-C. The applicant proposes to dig a trench and lay a pipe with catch basins and manholes to relieve drainage issues on Hamlin Street within the 100' buffer zone to a bordering vegetated wetland. The applicant is represented by Bob Rogers of G.A.F. Engineering Inc. Plan name is "Town of Acushnet DPW Street Improvements Project Hamlin Street" dated October 24, 2019.

New Business:

RDA – William A. Krause, Jr / 48 Lantern Lane A Request for Determination of Applicability was filed by William A. Krause, Jr., for property located at 48 Lantern Lane, Map 6 Lot 6. The applicant proposes to install a septic system with associated site grading within the 100’ buffer zone to a bordering vegetated wetland. The applicant is represented by Rick Charon of Charon Associates, Inc. – Engineers. Plan name is “Subsurface Sewage Disposal prepared for William A. Krause, Jr.” dated February 20, 2020.

RDA – Christopher Holiday / 22 Burr Avenue A Request for Determination of Applicability was filed by Christopher Holiday for property located at 22 Burr Avenue, Map 25 Lot 50A. The applicant proposes to remove Japanese knot weed and phragmites within the 100’ buffer zone to a bordering vegetated wetland. Plan name is “Sewage Disposal System for 22 Burr Avenue” dated September 2015.
