New Business:

RDA – **Acushnet Company** / **Manchester Lane** – A Request for Determination of Applicability was filed by Acushnet Company for property located at Manchester Lane, Map 11, Lot(s) 25C.34. The applicant is proposing to perform various remedial roadway repairs for a section of Manchester Lane. The repairs consist of supplementing existing bluestone shoulders, removing and repaving a small 15'X14' section of pavement and adding approximately 165 linear feet of bituminous concrete curb and is located within the 100 foot buffer zone to a bordering vegetated wetland. The applicant would like to know whether the work depicted on plan(s) referenced is subject to the Wetlands Protection Act. The applicant is represented by G.A.F. Engineering, Inc.
