Certificate of Compliance – Paul Boucher & Nancy Durfee – 7 Morton Lane SE 001-0566

A Certificate of Compliance was filed by Paul Boucher & Nancy Durfee for property located at 7 Morton Lane, Map 14, Lots 15H & 17. The applicant proposes the improvement/construction of a gravel roadway within an existing right of way, installation of associated drainage system, installation of proposed water main and construction of a residential dwelling with associated utilities, grading and driveway within the 100' buffer zone to a bordering vegetated wetland. Plan name is "Map 14 Lots 15H & 17 Morton Lane Existing Conditions Plan" dated May 25, 2021 revised August 9, 2021. Topographic as-built plan provided by Heureux Engineering, LLC, dated March 23, 2023 – review of matters presented, votes may be taken.
