NOI – Vieira Realty Trust / Andy's Court (SE001-XXXX) – A Notice of Intent was filed by Vieira Realty Trust for property located at Andy's Court, Map 9, Lot 31G. The applicant proposes to construct a 3-bedroom single family dwelling which will be partially located within the 100 ft. buffer zone of the bordering vegetated wetland, and install a 12X12 utility shed in the rear yard. The applicant is represented by N. Douglas Schneider & Associated, Inc. Plan name is "Sewage Disposal System – Site Plan for property located at Andy's Court in Acushnet, MA". Plan dated 11/16/17.
