You are invited to join us at one our open houses at the Acushnet Council on Aging in Acushnet on September 26 or Dartmouth Town Hall on September 27, 2018, between 5 p.m. and 7 p.m. This is an opportunity for you to learn more about proposed transmission system upgrades in your community.

The **Acushnet to Fall River Reliability Project** is a new transmission line that will be jointly constructed by Eversource and National Grid along an existing right of way (power line corridor). Spanning 12.1 miles from National Grid’s Bell Rock Station in Fall River to Eversource’s Industrial Park Tap in Acushnet, the project work will take place in portions of Acushnet, Dartmouth, Fall River and New Bedford.

The proposed project will improve the transmission system in your community, ensuring customers will continue to have reliable electric power to meet their growing energy needs. The Acushnet to Fall River Reliability Project will also ensure that the area’s electric grid conforms to national and regional reliability standards.

Since a portion of the proposed project route is located near your property, we are committed to keeping you updated as the project advances toward construction. In support of that effort, Eversource and National Grid will be holding two Open Houses to provide you with information and an opportunity meet with members of the project team and ask questions about the project.
